Appropriate Dress for Graduation

Gentlemen	White Shirt Dark colored tie (No red) Black/Khaki dress pants (no jeans) Black/Brown dress shoes (no tennis shoes or flip flops) Black socks No distracting jewelry, only school approved ribbons, etc. No decorations on caps/gowns
Ladies	Dress or Skirt and Blouse (appropriate color to coordinate with red robes) Black /White shoes (no high heels, tennis shoes or flip flops; avoid shoes difficult to climb and descend stairs) No distracting jewelry only school approved ribbons, etc. No decorations on caps/gowns

Special Reminders

***All books, fines, and equipment must be returned and/or paid to be eligible to walk at graduation.

***If you choose to hire your own photographer/videographer, they are NOT allowed to be on the field at any time before/during/after the ceremony.

*****Make-up time** due to absences must be completed as assigned.

***Those who must pass **final exams** must check with teachers.

*****Honor Graduate** cords can be purchased from Mrs. Simonton for \$8.

*****National Honor Society** members can pick up stoles from Mrs. Myers for \$12 .

Senior Day at the Park

To participate, you must be passing all classes, even Edmentum work, by May 14 at 4:00 p.m. If you are not passing, you will show up at normal school time and work on subjects you are not passing.

You will arrive at school by 9:00 and meet in the auditorium. While at school your attire must still fall under the dress code guidelines. The pool will be open for swimming along with other water toys in that area. When walking around the park and playing sand volleyball, etc, you must have clothes on; you cannot walk around in your swimsuit or without a shirt on.

This day is to celebrate the fact that you are a senior. Friends and family are not allowed at the park.

Lunch is usually served around 12:30. We will load back onto the buses and return to campus by 2:00 p.m. You will be dismissed for the day once we return.

Personal vehicles are not allowed at the park.



Baccalaureate Information

On Sunday, May 19, the Baccalaureate Ceremony will be held in the auditorium. Seniors who would like to participate by reading scriptures, poems, or singing may do so. Contact Mrs. Mack if you would like to participate.

Attendance is not mandatory.

Stadium Information

Seniors will be seated facing the east side of the stadium with only the west side open for seating. Parents will not be allowed on the field before, during or after the ceremony.

MWISD has several measures in place to ensure a safe and pleasant event for all. All guests will enter at the SE corner visitor gate. Handicap entrance will be on the SW side of the stadium, with only vehicles with identifying placards allowed. Bags and purses are screened. No coolers, air horns, or outside food/drink allowed. No one allowed to stand at stadium railing. As a courtesy to ALL students graduating, guests should stay in the stands until the ceremony has ended.



Inclement Weather

In case of inclement weather, the ceremony will be moved to the gymnasium. Seniors will be given tickets at practice and this will be based on the number of seniors who are graduating.

Following Graduation

After the graduation ceremony, go to the small gym to receive your diplomas. Tables will be set up along the wall. You will have 30 minutes from the time the ceremony is over until the doors are locked to get your diploma. If you fail to get back in time, you may pick up your diploma from the MWHS Office the following work day.

All Graduates who wear a NHS Collar must return his/her stole to Mrs. Myers in order for their deposit to be returned.
